ConnectRVA 2045 outlines more than 200 regional transportation projects to be completed over the next 20 years to support the growth of the Richmond Region. ConnectRVA 2045 is a plan for the entire Richmond Region. From Hanover to Charles City, this plan proposes transportation projects that will help enhance regional prosperity and connectedness for citizens and communities. Planned improvements include:

- New transit centers, park and rides, and dedicated lanes for buses
- New regional bike paths connecting with existing trails, bus stops, neighborhoods, employment centers, and schools
- New multi-use trails throughout the region
- Bridge replacements
- Highway maintenance and intersection enhancements
